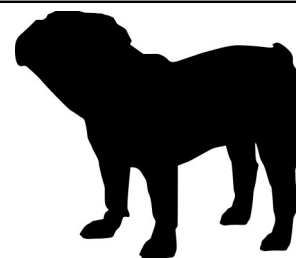

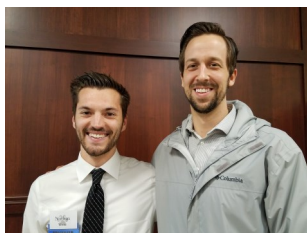
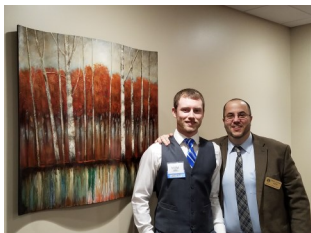
AT END OF YEAR PARTY—2017

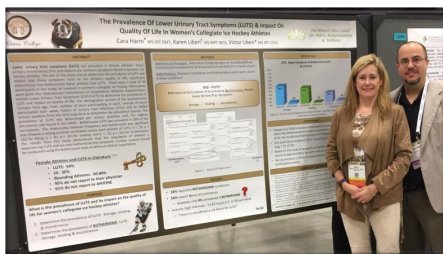

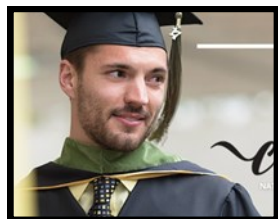
