We are committed to helping students find internships that will be valuable for their career path. All Adrian College students have access to our Handshake account where they will be able to filter for internships, find events, and jobs!

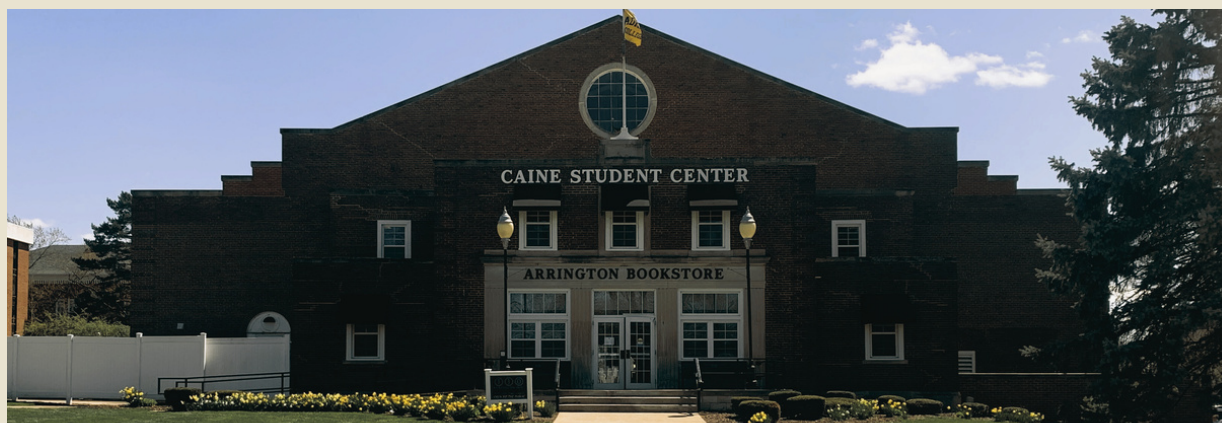
OCTOBER STUDENT OF THE MONTH
