This Fall, 2023 semester I have started an internship for the Michigan State Police at the Brighton Post. As a Criminal Justice major with a law enforcement track, this internship couldn't be a better fit. This internship has given me the opportunity to learn how law enforcement interacts with the community, how they conduct investigations, radiocommunications, fill out accident reports, fill out reports/complaints, along with the specific case laws that permit them to do their jobs on a daily basis. This position has also allowed me to see first-hand some of the chaotic occurrences that happen within the job itself such as searching for missing people, traffic stops, crashes, domestic violence cases, dealing with intoxicated people, drug overdoses, and seeing things that the rest of society is sheltered from. In addition, I have learned basic first aid procedures, in-dash/body camera procedures, radar detection for speed, placement of the squad cars for specific duties, and the importance of being detail oriented within the job.

This opportunity has opened many doors for me to start my career in law enforcement. Giving me a head start on what the job entails along with gaining connections with the Troopers and surrounding officers within the same jurisdiction. I am scheduled to graduate in May of 2024 and hope to attend the 146th Trooper recruit school in June of 2024.
