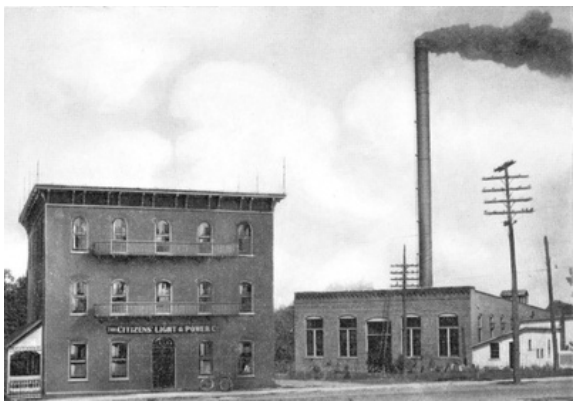


Take a Bulldog to Work Day
