MICHIGAN UNIFORM UNDERGRADUATE GUEST APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

This Form will serve as your application for admission as a guest student at a Michigan college or university. All prospective students should check with the Guest Institution to determine if additional requirements are required for admission or enrollment. This form does not ensure transferability of courses taken at the Guest Institution to the Home Institution.

Fill out PART I of the application. Then take it to the Registrar (or officer at your school who processes Guest Applications) where PART II will be completed and signed. The completed Guest Application will then be sent from the Home Institution to the school to which you are applying.

Guest Students.....

- 1. are subject to all the admission and registration regulations of the Guest Institution.
- 2. do not have permission to register as a degree candidate at the Guest Institution.
- 3. are responsible to determine that the Home Institution will accept credit earned as a guest student.
- 4. must understand that falsification of any part of the Guest Application may result in cancellation of admission and/or registration at the Guest Institution.
- 5. must arrange to have a transcript of any guest credit earned as a guest student sent from the Guest Institution back to the Home Institution.
- 6. wishing to apply for financial aid should verify their eligibility with the Guest Institution. (Revised 03/00)

INSTRUCTIONS TO ADRIAN COLLEGE STUDENTS

- 1. Courses which have been taken at Adrian College CANNOT be repeated at another institution for transfer credit.
- 2. Only courses in which the grades earned are "C" (2.00) or higher will be accepted.
- 3. Grades earned as a Guest Student DO NOT count in your Adrian College grade point average and will not be recorded on your transcript.
- 4. Courses will be accepted only on a "credit for credit" basis. Credits from an institution on the QUARTER system transfer as follows: three (3) QUARTER hours are equivalent to TWO (2) semester hours. A four (4) QUARTER hour courses will transfer as TWO AND TWO-THIRDS (2-2/3) semester hours and can satisfy a three (3) hour requirement. Only whole numbers of credit (no fractions) are recorded as transfer credit to count towards graduation (i.e. 2 instead of 2-2/3). Two courses of four (4) QUARTER hours will transfer as a total of 5 (five) semester hours towards graduation. Graduation requires a minimum of 124 semester hours of credit.
- 5. You must request an official transcript be sent from the Registrar's Office at the institution attended directly to the Adrian College Registrar's Office.
- 6. Students enrolled at another institution, or concurrently enrolled at Adrian College and another institution, may not enroll for more than the permissible class load at Adrian College (19 hours in fall or spring; 4 hours in May term; 8 hours in summer term).
